




#### PALETTE

- Big white
- 70% white, 30% black
- Black

--Special bright blue  
--Special bright green  
\*\*use the neon colors Marissa has stashed away just for this painting. You could do these with reg blue and green but it doesn't look very nice.

#### BRUSHES

- Round
- 1/2" flat



Using any brush,  
outline the football /  
almond shape eye in  
black




Mixing the black/  
white area, add in  
these big grey areas  
(ideally your paint is a  
little marbled looking  
so the colors aren't too  
consistent but instead  
streaky with some  
black and white)




While the grey is still  
wet, mix in some of  
your pure white.



**IMPORTANT:** keep  
some of your pure  
white to the side (but  
only a tiny bit)



Fill in the rest of the large areas with black leaving NO room between black and grey




While black is still wet, mix some grey into the black near the medium-grey areas to create dark-grey areas



Using the round, fill in the eye then blend together

Make sure all areas if full but be VERY careful not to mix in any black that surrounds it

Put in the rest of your black for an eye. Should be half-circle NOT a full circle and NOT in the center of the eye or he'll look like he's on cocaine.



Add tiny globs of white using your rounds. Like, pick up a bunch and then tab it on so lightly the brush doesn't even touch the wet paint under it.
